AMENDED ORDER #1

**AMENDED ORDER REGARDING \*SUITE 1310 and \*\*270<sup>th</sup> COURTROOM**

Whereas based on growing public health concerns in Harris County arising from COVID-19, and as provided in "COVID-19 Operating Plan for the Harris County Judiciary District Courts, County Courts at Law & Probate Courts" issued on 5/21/2020 by Local Administrative District Judge:

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. **All** persons entering \*Suite 1310 are required to wear the following personal protection equipment in order to gain entry, or to work, in the area, at all times:
  - a) Face coverings (must cover BOTH nose and mouth) and
  - b) Gloves, as well as
  - c) Engage in the social distancing (preferably at least 6 feet apart, when possible).

A face covering and/or gloves can be provided upon request, *PRIOR TO* entry of \*Suite 1310, while supplies last.

2. **All** persons entering the \*\*270<sup>th</sup> courtroom, are required to wear the following personal protection equipment in order to gain entry, or to work, in the area, at all times:
  - a) Face coverings (must cover BOTH nose and mouth) and
  - b) Gloves, as well as
  - c) Engage in the social distancing (preferably at least 6 feet apart, when possible).

A face covering and/or gloves can be provided upon request, *PRIOR TO* entry of \*\*270<sup>th</sup> Courtroom, while supplies last.

After weighing the constitutional rights set forth in the Texas and United States Constitutions, the Court concludes that this Order does not infringe upon any person's constitutional rights or run afoul of any other constitutional limitations.

\*Suite 1310 includes room numbers 1311, 1312, 1313, 1315, 1316, 1317, 1318, 1319, and 1320.

\*\*270<sup>th</sup> Courtroom includes 270 Conf-A and 270 Conf-B.
