

351st Court PSI/MRP/MAJ Hearings with Associate Judges

For all cases in which the court refers a PSI Hearing, a Motion to Revoke Probation Hearing, or a Motion to Adjudicate Guilt Hearing to an associate judge, counsel should expect the following:

- To be prepared for the setting as stated by the home court;
- To be contacted by an Associate Judge coordinator promptly;
- To present evidence and arguments before an associate judge, with a court reporter, in the same fashion that it would do so before the home court;
- That the Associate Judge will submit written applicable findings of facts and recommendations that will be made available to counsel for review;
- For a subsequent Final setting, on the record, before the home court for disposition.
