



**ELEVENTH ADMINISTRATIVE JUDICIAL REGION OF TEXAS
INTERIM ADOPTION OF
REGIONAL RULES OF ADMINISTRATION OF
THE SECOND ADMINISTRATIVE JUDICIAL REGION OF TEXAS**

ORDER

The Council of Presiding Judges¹ must approve any regional rules of administration before those rules can go into effect. *See* TEX. R. JUD. ADMIN 3, *reprinted in* GOV'T CODE tit. 2, subtit. F app.

In the absence of any approved regional rules for the Eleventh Judicial Region, the Presiding Judge ORDERS that the Eleventh Region will proceed under the Regional Rules of Administration of the Second Administrative Judicial Region of Texas.² Those Rules will remain in effect until the Council of Presiding Judges approve the proposed Regional Rules of Administration for the Eleventh Administrative Judicial Region.
