## Harris County Felony Mental Health Court Overview

Harris County District Courts, Criminal Division

The Harris County Felony Mental Health Court (FMHC) is a collaborative, problem-solving court in which probationers living with a mental illness adhere to a judicially supervised Re-Entry Plan developed and monitored by mental health professionals

### FMHC Program Description

- Voluntary entry client will be advised of program requirements and will be encouraged to review benefits and any perceived detriments of participation with counsel
- Clients admitted to the court receive **deferred adjudication or probation**
- Client must be willing to undergo a clinical evaluation and agree to adhere to an individualized Re-Entry Plan
- **Individualized, graduated incentives and sanctions** are applied in order to encourage adherence to the Re-Entry Plan and to modify behavior leading to potential criminal activity
- Must complete **at least 18 months in the court**; Judge will consider early termination of probation as allowed by law
- **Referrals** into the FMHC are generated by other courts, counsel and other sources

#### Inclusion Criteria (All criteria must be met)

- Diagnosis of a Serious and Persistent Mental Illness
  - Schizophrenia/Schizoaffective Disorder
  - Bipolar Disorder
  - Major Depressive Disorder
  - > May have a co-occurring substance abuse disorder
- Legally competent;
  - Identified relationship between the mental illness and the behavior which resulted in the criminal charge;
- Felony offense;
  - Assaultive offenses and offenses involving possession or use of a firearm will be considered on a case by case basis
- Willing to engage in a risk assessment and clinical evaluation, on-going mental health treatment and, if needed, substance abuse treatment and comply with terms of Community Supervision

#### Exclusion Criteria

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- Past or current charge of a sex offense
- More than one (1) previous DWI offense
- Primary diagnosis of a substance abuse disorder
- Currently on parole

For acceptance into the FMHC, *appropriate community resources must be available* to address identified treatment needs. If a candidate is determined to be ineligible, the FMHC will ensure that the referring court or attorney is provided with a written explanation and, if indicated, a recommendation for a specific type of treatment and/or a referral to a more appropriate specialty court.

# The mission of the Harris County Felony Mental Health Court is to divert defendants living with mental illness from incarceration and instead facilitating linkage to appropriate treatment and community resources
