STANDING ORDER IN LIMINE

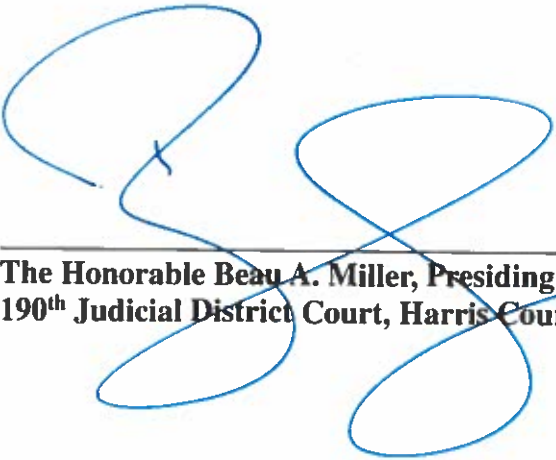
On this day, the Court enters this Standing Order in Limine for all cases in the 190th District Court. All parties and their attorneys, representatives, and witnesses called to testify in the trial of this case are instructed to refrain from alluding to, referencing, or otherwise making any mention of, directly or indirectly, or otherwise attempting to introduce the matters sustained as limine in voir dire examination of the jurors, in opening statements, presentation of evidence, arguments before the Court, final argument, or at any other time during the course of the proceedings, until Plaintiff's counsel approaches the bench out of the presence and hearing of the jury panel or jury and obtains a ruling on admissibility.

The matters to which reference is prohibited by this order are as follows:

1. **Liability or Non-Liability for Third Parties.** Inquiring of potential jurors as to the potential liability they would place on responsible third parties or settling Defendants.
2. **Deaths Not Pertaining to the Case.** Mentioning deaths that are not at issue in the current trial.
3. **Jurors' Knowledge of Movies and TV.** Inquiring of potential jurors as to their present or past knowledge of Movies and TV shows.

It is so **ORDERED**.
